- 4. Some post-processing is OK (adjusting white balance, exposure, color saturation), but let's try to stay away from heavily PP'ed images here. Try to keep the creativity to photographic techniques and the captures themselves.
- 5. There is one "Theme Concept" labeled "black and white," but feel free to post black and white, sepia, monotone, etc., for any of the other themes.
- 6. The picture you post should be taken during the week in which the theme is active to be eligible for judging.
- 7. Any picture taken from 20090705 to listed closing date is acceptable for the two "Seasonal" competitions Projects 52-2-51 & 52!
